Description: For this event Broom were made as well as purchased. Brooms were made by the people in slums. Cleanliness Abhiyaan was done in presence of honorable guests. For purpose of human chain, Tulsi Plants were purchased and distributed among the people

Expenses incurred: Banners and leaflets and bamboo sticks purchased for making brooms amounted 11500/- Labor for making brooms from bamboo sticks amounted 21000/- volunteer expenses incurred for conveyance, refreshments, etc. amounted to 350000/-. Brooms of 32000/- were purchased. Welcome expenses for guest amounted to 5300/-. Snacks and food expenses incurred were Rs. 4900/-. Transportation expenses were Rs.1500/- 2000/- Tulsi & Neem plants were purchased for human chain costing Rs. 6500/-. Total expenses incurred INR **4,34,700/-**.

Activities: Awareness – Stop using plastic bags and use Eco friendly bags.

People Participated: People of different age group participated which included General Public, Hawkers, Auto Rickshaw drivers, School kids, Volunteers, etc

Description: Plastic was one of the main reason for the Floods that the Navi Mumbai. So in order to avoid this calamity it is necessary to remove the cause from its roots.

Event Highlights:

- Paperobag India Ltd. had provided 7500 paper bags which were distributed among people. They were also educated to use cotton bags instead of plastic bags.
- People were told that the main reasons for flood is plastic and the impact of use of plastic on environment.
- A special public was organized to create awareness among hawkers, vegetable vendors and others regarding the hazardous effects of plastic bags.

Other Activities:

- ❖ Basic hygiene was discussed and taught like the importance of washing hands before eating, avoiding street food, drinking boiled water were explained.
- ❖ They were told how spitting in public is mere invitation to diseases like TB etc.
- ❖ Importance of education was explained.

Expenses incurred: As the Paper Bag & Cotton Bags were distributed so expenses were 275 per head, Paperobag India Ltd. sponsored **Rs. 1,65,000/-**

Description:

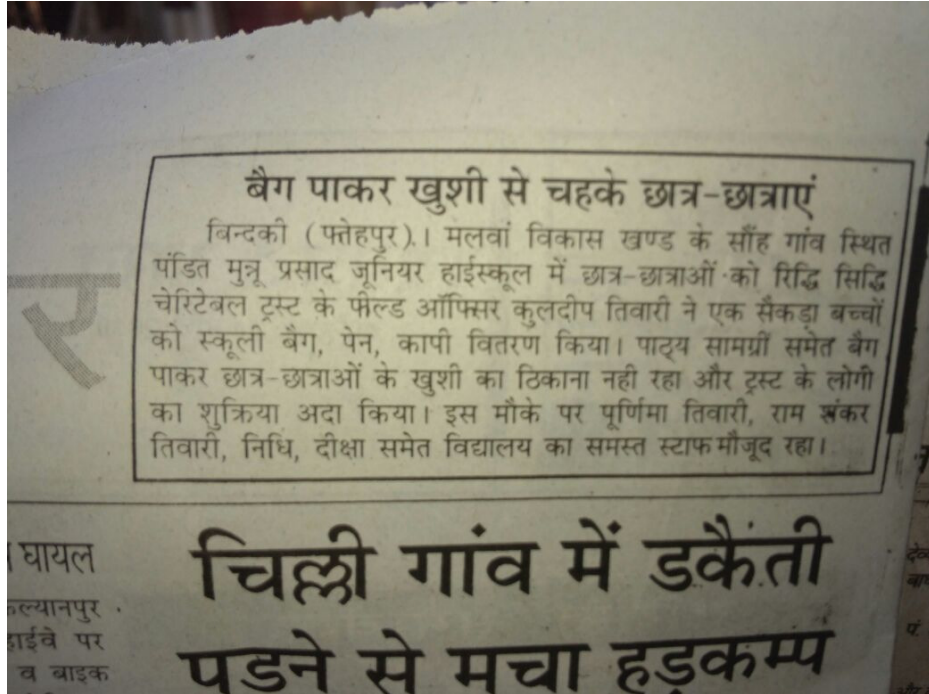

Cost of 800 Cloth bags purchased was Rs. 260000/- all stationaries and its transportation expenses amounted to Rs. 3800/-.
