Expenses incurred: Banners and leaflets and bamboo sticks purchased for making brooms amounted 18000/- Labour for making brooms from bamboo sticks amounted 25000/volunteer expenses incurred for conveyance, refreshments, etc. amounted to 415000/-. Brooms of 45000/- were purchased. Welcome expenses for guest amounted to 8500/-. Snacks and food expenses incurred were Rs. 7400/-. Transportation expenses were Rs.2200/- 3500/- Tulsi & Neem plants were purchased for human chain costing Rs. 8700/-. Total expenses incurred INR 5,33,300/-.

Description: Plastic was one of the main reason for the Floods that the Navi Mumbai. So in order to avoid this calamity it is necessary to remove the cause from its roots.

Event Highlights:

- ➤ We have distributed 18000 Eco-friendly among carry bags to peoples. They were also educated to use cotton bags instead of plastic bags.
- People were told that the main reasons for flood is plastic and the impact of use of plastic on environment.
- ➤ A special public was organized to create awareness among hawkers, vegetable vendors and others regarding the hazardous effects of plastic bags.

Expenses incurred: As the Paper Bag & Cotton Bags were distributed so expenses were 350 per head x 525 (volunteers & peoples participated)= Rs. 1,83,750/, and Bags = $18000 \times Rs. 3/- = 54,000/- total expenses amounting$ **Rs. 2,37,750/-**


