Brooms of 55000/- were purchased. Welcome expenses for guest amounted to 1100/-. Snacks and food expenses incurred were Rs. 8800/-. Transportation expenses were Rs.2700/- 4000/- Tulsi & Neem plants were purchased for human chain costing Rs. 11500/-. Total expenses incurred INR **5,63,400/-**.

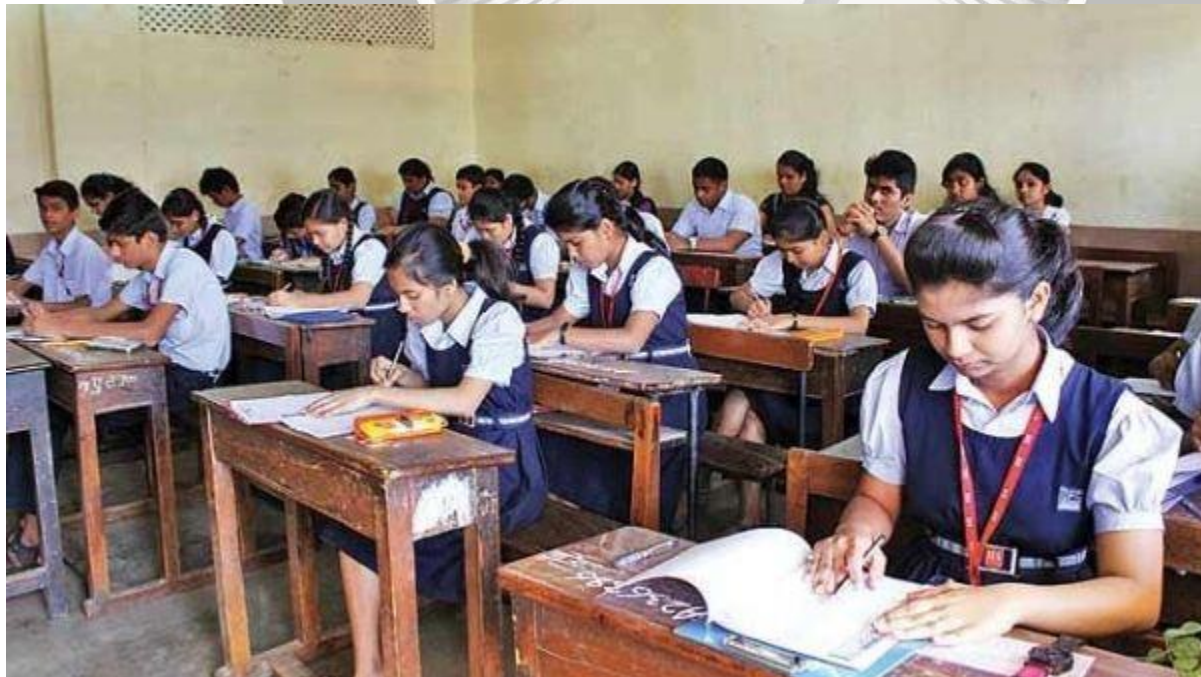
